
COLD LAKE OPERATIONS

Strathcona Resources Ltd. is one of North America's fastest growing pure play heavy oil producers. Our operations are concentrated near the **Cold Lake** and Lloydminster regions of Alberta and Saskatchewan.

Strathcona's Cold Lake Thermal business includes thermal oil producing assets at Lindbergh, Orion and Tucker, with production from best-in-class steam-assisted gravity drainage (SAGD) oil assets.

COLD LAKE ASSETS

COLD LAKE THERMAL

Strathcona's Cold Lake Thermal assets include Lindbergh, Orion and Tucker with production from best-in-class steam-assisted gravity drainage (SAGD) oil assets.

SAGD is a method that is widely used to extract bitumen from underground oil deposits. This method involves introducing steam into the subsurface oil sands deposit to heat the bitumen in the sand, allowing it to flow by gravity to horizontal wells placed at the base of the reservoir. Strathcona's operations have minimal surface impacts as they do not use open pit mining techniques.

"Cold Lake Thermal is our highest producing business unit at Strathcona. We use Steam-Assisted Gravity Drainage (SAGD) at our facilities to produce high quality bitumen from underground oil deposits. ABOUT COLD LAKE


Cold Lake, Alberta is a vibrant city located in northeastern Alberta, nestled on the shores of Cold Lake itself, one of the province's largest and deepest lakes. With a population of ~15,000, the city offers a balanced lifestyle that blends small-town charm with modern amenities. Cold Lake is well-known for its outdoor recreational opportunities, including boating, fishing, camping and access to nearby Cold Lake Provincial Park.

Cold Lake is home to a variety of education options including Portage College, close proximity to Lakeland College, along with a number of public, Catholic and French immersion elementary and secondary schools.

Cold Lake's local economy is anchored by a strong mix of military, energy, and service sectors, providing stability and diverse employment opportunities. The city is home to "4 Wing Cold Lake", one of Canada's busiest fighter bases, contributing to a stable local economy and a strong sense of community.

Additionally, the oil and gas industry is a significant driver in the region, particularly with Cold Lake being a hub for oil sands development and related services. These industries are complemented by a growing retail and tourism sector, fueled by seasonal visitors drawn to the lake and nearby recreational areas.

RECREATION

Cold Lake offers exceptional year-round recreation, making it a paradise for outdoor enthusiasts in every season. In the warmer months, Cold Lake itself provides endless opportunities for boating, fishing, swimming and paddleboarding, while nearby Cold Lake Provincial Park offers scenic hiking and camping. During the colder months, Cold Lake offers ice fishing, cross-country skiing, snowmobiling, and skating. 
WORKING AT STRATHCONA

Strathcona is a proud supporter of the Stepping Stones Crisis Centre in Cold Lake, Alberta. Stepping Stones' mission is to provide safe spaces, emergency shelter, and resources to women and children in crisis. The community-focused services ensure that no one faces abuse or family crisis alone.

Strathcona's \$100,000 commitment recently helped Stepping Stones open 63 new emergency beds, nearly doubling their capacity.



In partnership with the Clayton Bellamy Foundation for the Arts, Strathcona also contributed to the creation of the Strathcona Performing Arts Centre in nearby Bonnyville, AB. A \$250,000 contribution toward the project helped fund the construction of the 350-seat theatre that is the home for showcasing local talent, entertaining community audiences, supporting aspiring artists and helping bring increased artistic opportunity to the entire Lakeland region.
